For your last reading requirement, you will be reading various selections from your literature book and from the novel, *And Then There Were None*. You will need to read a minimum of 10 selections and write a response to literature. You are required to read from each type of genre.

Use page 15 of your Agenda to write a response. Some responses do not lend themselves to each selection, so choose your response after you read the selection. **You may NOT use the same response more than once.**

Each response should be answered in the following manner:

Title of the selection in quotes (*And Then There Were None* italicized or underlined)  
 Author  
 Type of Genre  
 Response #

Type or write (blue or black pen) your response. Your response must be answered thoroughly and written in paragraph form. It should have a topic sentence, several supporting sentences, and a concluding sentence. Revise your work to include sentence variety and proofread for convention errors.

Use the table of content and/or the Index of Authors and Titles to find the selections in the literature book.
